There are 1 displayed terms in the matrix.

The matrix starts at Matthew Ch 5 V 44 Letter 102 and ends at Matthew Ch 23 V 1 Letter 26.

The matrix spans 1075261 characters of the surface text.

The matrix has 61 rows, is 1 columns wide and contains a total of 61 characters.

Note: לכרת י' above translated, "to cut me a covenant" can also be translated, "for cottages". See Zeph. 2:6

Translation:

He seized a garment ,behold, to make me a covenant of light from JAH, while I made His women guests sick with a delicacy steaming in the shadow. Judging by blood on a thick beam was horrifying , while Jesus Christ was baking on a pedestal of travail.

1st Alternate translation:

He seized a measuring rod , behold , to cut me a covenant of light from JAH, while I made His women guests sick with a delicacy steaming under a shadow. Pleading in blood under a thick cloud was horrifying , while Jesus Christ was baking on a pedestal of travail.

2nd Alternate translation:

He seized a measuring rod , behold, for cottages of light from JAH. It is a sign for us. A delicacy was steaming under the shadow. Pleading in blood on a thick beam was horrifying , while Jesus Christ was baking on a pedestal of travail.

This 61 letter code is from the *Peshitta Version* of Matthew and is my very first attempt to find a code in The Peshitta N.T. I used Codefinder 1.21 and had search wrap on , making this a toroidal search, going around Matthew 18.6 times , the skip being 17,921 ! The R factor is 66.98 for this one ELS !

That translates to a probability of 1 in 10 to the 67th power (1 with 67 zeroes after it) in a text the size and letter makeup of the Aramaic gospel of Matthew.

I believe this code speaks of the Incarnation and Crucifixion of The LORD (Yahweh) Jesus The Messiah. The cloth "He seized" was the cloth of human flesh taken in His conception and birth of the virgin Mary through The Holy Spirit. The word, **כָּבַד, "seized" denotes violent victory over and possession of something or someone. God conquered the flesh of humanity when He took it on Himself , thus demonstrating complete mastery over temptation ,sin and the power of death.**

The apostle Paul speaks of the body as a tent , which was woven of wool or camel hair. God transformed Himself -the Light

of the cosmos - into human flesh and blood to become our Passover and atonement Lamb and our High Priest to take away the sin of the world. "Jah" ,The O.T. shortened version of Yahweh or Jehovah, Himself was the material of which the covenant was made , making it eternal , infallible , almighty and unbreakable.

"Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me:

Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second.

By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once [for all]." Hebr 10:5 ,9,10

God prepared a body for the Messiah before His entry into the world. *The will of God is His New Covenant* and that is consummated in the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all !

What , you may ask , is meant by , "**The LORD made His women guests sick with a delicacy steaming in the shadow.** ? The LORD (Yahweh) Himself was the One Who made the covenant ; The LORD was the One from Whom the covenant was cut (The material) and The LORD was the steaming delicacy (*Living Bread*)-*John 6:51*, baking "**on a thick beam**" - "**the pedestal of travail**", under the darkness of God's terrible judgement against the sin of the world. The cross was the place where God's judgement was exhausted and the sin offering was consumed. Surely His women guests at the cross were sick in heart as they beheld this scene of the suffering of the incarnate God of Heaven.
